# "Plan for the worst, Work for the best"

The original estimate for the electric project was \$300.00 per member. This was a worst-case scenario, which included the replacement of all components of the system, wiring, transformers, connection panels, etc. It also allowed a percentage for unexpected occurrences.

As it turns out, all but one of the transformers can remain in service for now. The contractor was able to complete the job without any unexpected incidents, and the cost of the total project was very close to the Board's best case scenario.

The project is complete, with the exception of some minor reparation work to some lots and follow-up testing of transformers in July. The contractor will be returning sometime in May to start reparations on the lots and roadways.

As of this date, the issue with electric current in the pool has also been resolved.

The Electric Project assessment invoices were mailed to all members on May 1, 2013. The project came in under budget and the cost per member is \$171.00. Payment for this invoice is due by August 1, 2013. After August 1st there will be a \$20.00 late charge. If payment is not received by the September 1st annual meeting the member will forfeit their membership.

Your timely payment of the invoice is greatly appreciated. Payments are applied immediately to our loan balance, so the sooner your payment is received, the less loan interest we pay.


#### Youth Committee
