RULES AND POLCY CHANGE

At the June 18, 2017 Board Meeting, the following change to Rules and Policies were approved by the Board.

1. Rule 6 g: Amended the rule to remove "freezer".
2. Rule 6 g i: Added "One small freezer up to 7.1 cf or one refrigerator in shed. Association will not be responsible for any loss of contents of freezer or refrigerator."
